OR (AFTERNOON/EVENING) LUKE 24:13-35

What does to rise from the dead mean? To use the words of the Beloved Disciple, who peered into the tomb empty and "saw and believed". What do we see today and in what do we believe?

We "see" in our mind's eve, with the early witnesses Mary Magdalene, Peter, the Beloved Disciple, two on the road to Emmaus and the rest, first the empty

tomb. What does this mean? Did someone take the body? But Jesus convinces them, among them doubting Thomas, that he is alive and in the flesh. Something new. Jesus raised the little girl and Lazarus from the dead, but they would die again. Jesus died and rose in the flesh to never be subject to death in his human body.

God exists from all eternity. At some point God created something apart from his self and the universe began to unfold in time. At some point we came along. Made in the image and likeness of God, that is we can know and we can love. But in freedom we succumbed to the disorder of sin.

Resurrection is the healing of that primal disorder. God, who is Triune, by the will of the Father, the Son took flesh in the power of the Holy Spirit in the womb of Mary and became subject to death. For the purpose that we might become the very holiness of God through the grace of God's self-giving in the Son who loved us even to death and makes that grace available to us through the power of the Holy Spriit in the Church through Word and Sacrament and the communal life.

But we still do not understand because we do not yet see. The Beloved Disciple sees and believes. That sight is the grace to seek. Peter comes to that, but later. Let this be the time for us to move a bit more or better a lot more to the deep surrender in faith. Thomas would not believe, unless. He put down his "unless" when we saw the Risen Lord and was addressed by Jesus. The Lord wants to do the same with and for us. The resurrection is more than a resuscitation. It is the fulfillment of our identity with God as made in His image and likeness, healed from all sin and division.

We encounter Jesus today in the Mass, fundamentally. In Word and Sacrament, and in the life of the Church for the baptized are members of his body. Faithful to the Word of God, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. We discern the Body in the Church, for all the baptized are members of Christ, and in the Eucharist. We what we eat, we become, the Body and Bood of Christ. Paschal greetings!
